



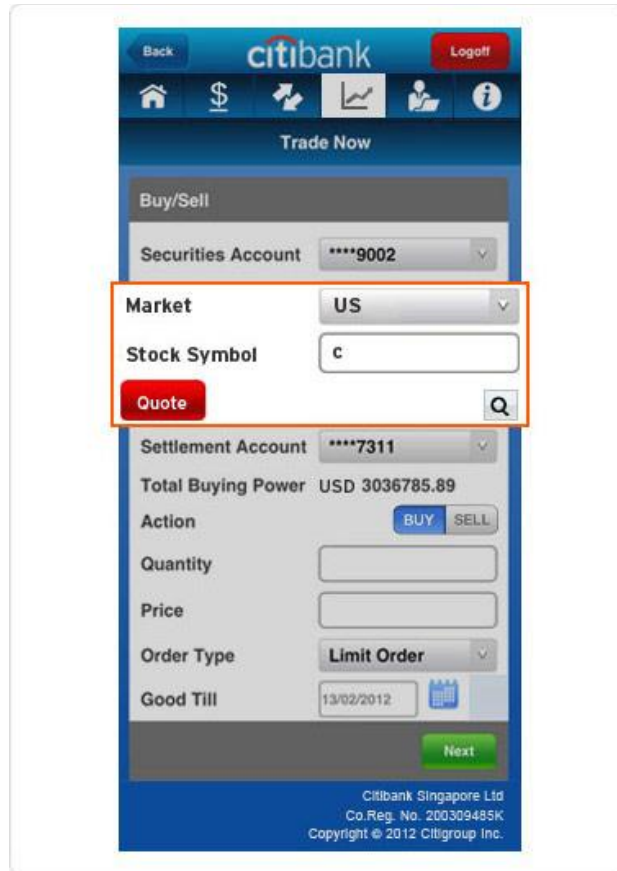
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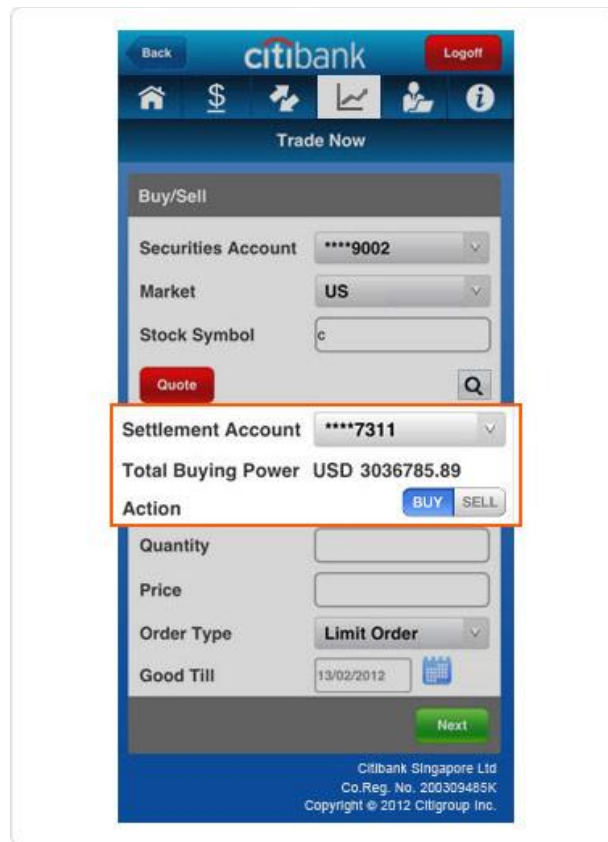
Buy and Sell Securities

Step 1: Click on the  icon and select "Trade Now" from the menu.

Step 2: Select the market you like to trade in and enter the stock symbol. The  icon enables you to search for a list of stock names and stock codes. You can also view the details of the stock quote by clicking on the "Quote" button.



Step 3: Select your preferred settlement account and select the "BUY" or "SELL" action. (For "Sell" action, the amount will be displayed when you click the "Sellable Quantity" button.) Please note that foreign exchange will apply for currencies in another denomination.



Step 4: Enter the quantity and price and select the order type. If you have selected "Limit Order", enter the "Good Till" standing instructions. For more information on the minimum quantity for trading, [Click here](#).

Trade Status

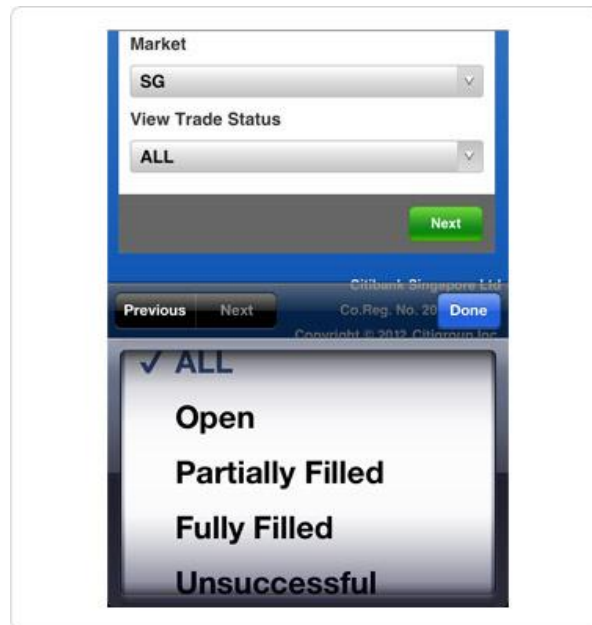
Monitor and check if your trade orders are open, partially filled or filled.

Step 3: Select the type of trade status you like to view and click "Next".

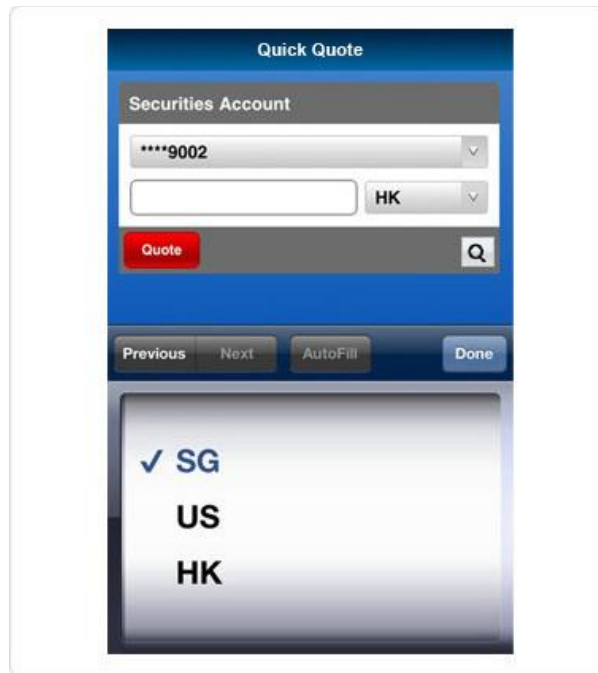


Get Quotes And Market News

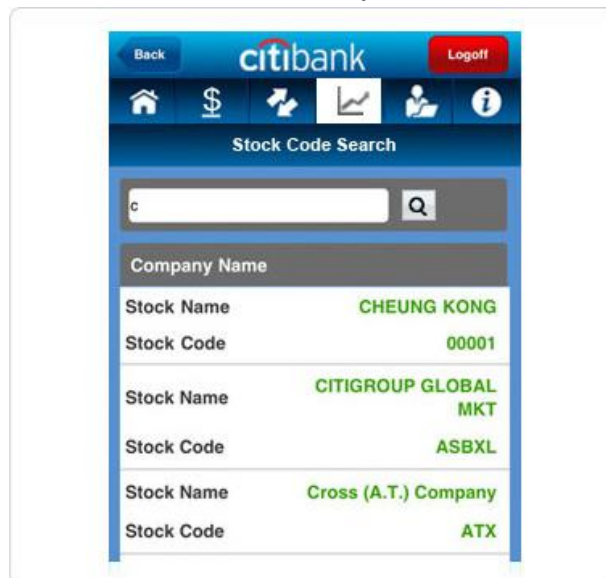
Quick Quote enables you to view real-time stock quotes to seize trading opportunities.

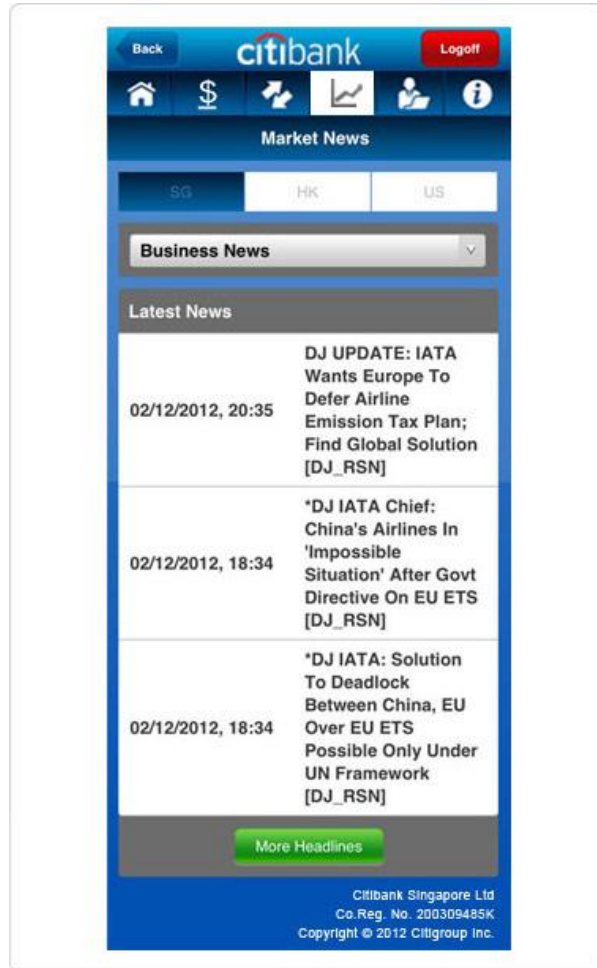


Step 3: Upon selecting the stock, click the "Quote" button for your Quick Quote.

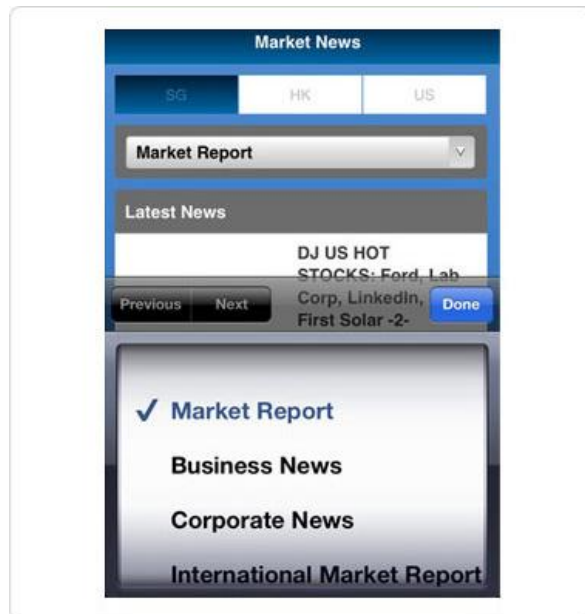


Stay up-to-date with industry news and corporate actions.

Step 2: To view other news categories, you can select from the dropdown bar.

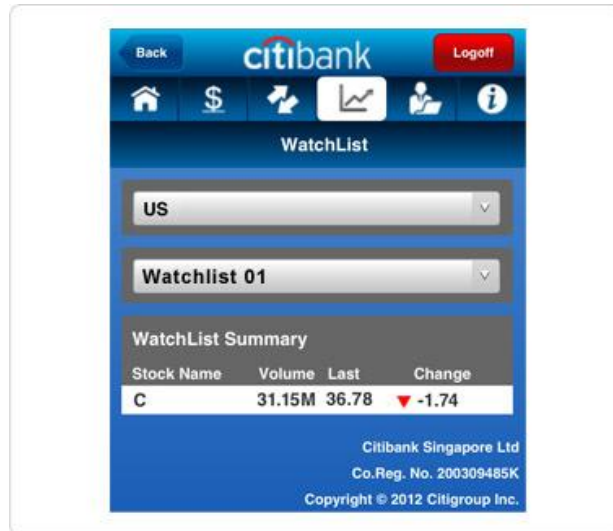


Watchlist

Step 1: Upon clicking on  icon and select "Watchlist" from the menu.

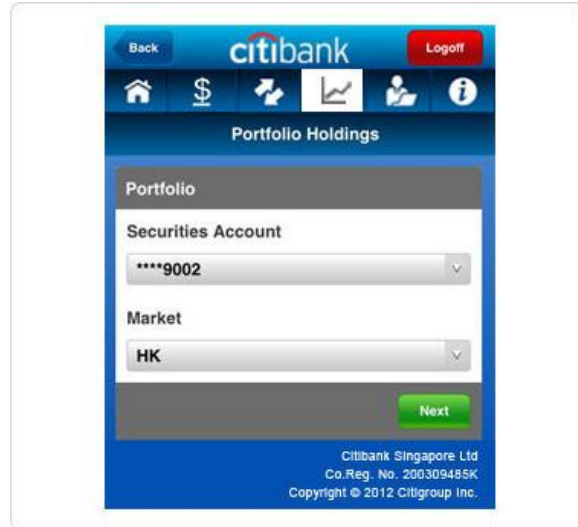
Step 2: Select the market and your watchlist from the dropdown bar. A summary of the stocks in your watchlist would be displayed.



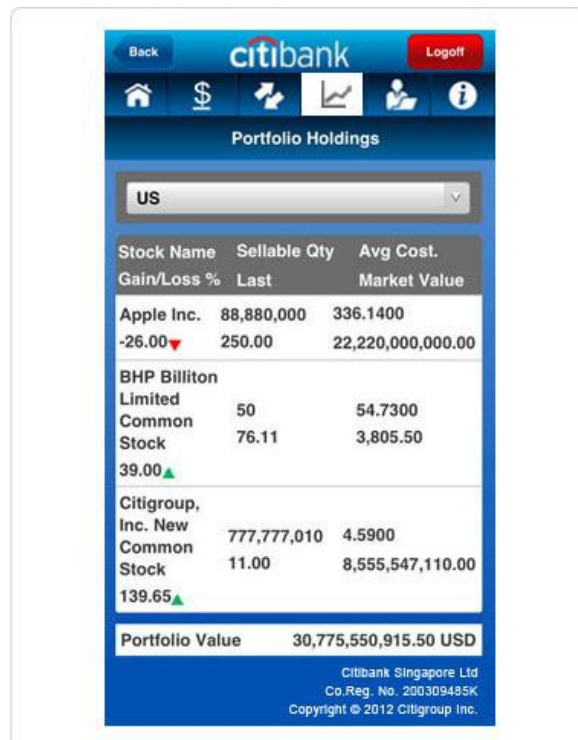
View Your Account And Portfolio

View your securities holding at a glance to know your trading position.

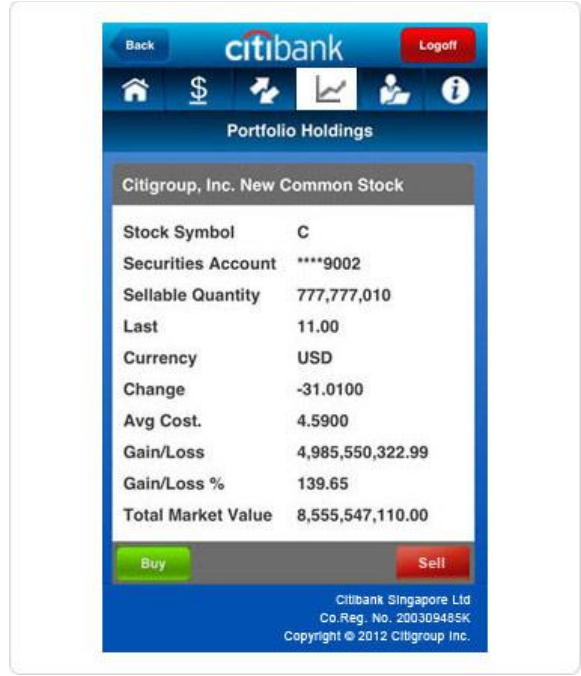
Step 1: Click on the  icon and select "Portfolio Holdings" from the menu.
